

Functions of the Assistant Pack Scouter

1. ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE PACK SCOUTER in providing wholesome, interesting and active Cubbing for the Cubs in the Pack, adhering to all provisions in Policy, Organisation and Rules (PO&R) pertaining to the duties, functions and responsibilities of an Assistant Pack Scouter, with particular reference to Rule 630.
2. Attend Pack meetings, Pack Scouters meetings, Group Scouters meetings, Seonee Pack meetings and District Scouters meetings.
3. Share in the planning and preparation of the Pack meetings, taking on the responsibility for those items on the programme allocated to you.
4. Actively support Group, District and Area events.
5. Actively participate in the outdoor programme in the Pack, taking on the responsibility of organising activities and outings allocated to you in the Pack's programme.
6. In consultation with the Pack Scouter, accept responsibility for any tasks which will contribute to the progress and good administration of the Pack and which could include:
 - (a) Record keeping;
 - (b) Training and testing of Cubs in the requirements of the badge advancement Programme;
 - (c) Parent visiting.
7. Be enthusiastic, committed and set an example to others by living up to the Scout Law and Promise.
